Tuesday 10/13	Ephesians 2:8- For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith- and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God.

Tuesday 10/20	Second Commandment and Meaning: You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God. Meaning: We should fear and love God so that we do not curse, swear, use satanic arts, lie, or deceive by His name, but call upon it in every trouble, pray, praise, and give thanks.
Friday 10/23	Third Commandment and Meaning: Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. Meaning: We should fear and love God so that we do not despise preaching and His Word, but hold it sacred and gladly hear and learn it.
Tuesday 10/27	Romans 10:27- Faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word of Christ.
Friday 10/30	Fourth Commandment and Meaning: Honor our father and your mother. Meaning: We should fear and love God so that we do not despise or anger our parents and other authorities, but honor them, serve and obey them, love and cherish them.
Tuesday 11/3	Ephesians 4:32- Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.
Friday 11/6	Fifth Commandment and Meaning: You shall not murder. Meaning: We should fear and love God so that we do not hurt or harm our neighbor in his body, but help and support him in every physical need.

Friday 11/13	1 John 4:19- We love because He first loved us.
Tuesday 11/17	Sixth Commandment and Meaning: You shall not commit adultery. Meaning: We should fear and love God so that we lead a sexually pure and decent life in what we say and do, and husband and wife love and honor each other.
Friday 11/20	Seventh Commandment and Meaning: You shall not steal. Meaning: We should fear and love God so that we do not take our neighbor's money or possessions, or get them in any dishonest way, but help him to improve and protect his possessions and income.
Tuesday 11/24	Eighth Commandment and Meaning: You shall not give false testimony against your

	neighbor. Meaning: We should fear and love God so that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, slander him, or hurt his reputation, but defend him, speak well of him, and explain everything in the kindest way.

Tuesday 12/1	Psalm 51:1- Have mercy on me, O God, according to Your unfailing love.
Friday 12/4	Ninth Commandment and Meaning: You shall not covet your neighbor's house. Meaning: We should fear and love God so that we do not scheme to get our neighbor's inheritance or house, or get it in a way which only appears right, but help and be of service to him in keeping it.
Tuesday 12/8	1 Chronicles 16:23- Sing to the Lord, all the earth; proclaim His salvation day after day.
Friday 12/11	Tenth Commandment and Meaning: You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor. Meaning: We should fear and love God so that we do not entice or force away our neighbor's wife, workers, or animals, or turn them against him, but urge them to stay and do their duty.
Tuesday 12/15	Matthew 1:21- She will give birth to a son, and you are to give Him the name Jesus, because He will save His people from their sins.
Friday 12/18	Luke 2:10-11- Do not be afraid. I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; He is Christ the Lord.
Tuesday 1/5	Luke 2:40- And the child grew and became strong; He was filled with wisdom, and the grace of God was upon Him.
Friday 1/8	Introduction to the Lord's Prayer, as well as the First and Second Petitions: Our Father who art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come
Tuesday 1/12	Matthew 6:33- Seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.
Friday 1/15	The Lord's Prayer, Third, Fourth, and Fifth Petitions: Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us.

Friday 1/29	Apostles' Creed, First Article and Meaning (Part 1): I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth. Meaning: I believe that God has made me and all creatures; that He has given Me my body and soul, eyes, ears, and all my members, my reason and all my senses, and still takes care of them.
Tuesday 2/2	Psalm 34:1- The righteous cry out, and the Lord hears them; He delivers them from all their troubles.
Friday 2/5	Apostles' Creed, First Article and Meaning (Part 2): He also gives me clothing and shoes, food and drink, house and home, wife and children, land, animals, and all I have. He richly and daily provides me with all that I need to support this body and life.
Tuesday 2/9	Jeremiah 31:3- The Lord says, "I have loved you with an everlasting love."
Friday 2/12	Apostles' Creed, First Article and Meaning (Part 3): He defends me against all danger and guards and protects me from all evil. All this He does only out of fatherly, divine goodness and mercy, without any merit or worthiness in me. For all this it is my duty to thank and praise, serve and obey Him. This is most certainly true.
Tuesday 2/16	Matthew 28:19- Go and make disciples of all nations.

Friday 2/19	Apostles' Creed, Second Article: And in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into Hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. From thence he will come to judge the living and the dead.
Tuesday 2/23	1 Corinthians 15:57- Thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
Friday 2/26	Apostles' Creed, Second Article (see above) and Meaning (Part 2): What does this mean? I believe that Jesus Christ true God, begotten of the Father from eternity, and also true man, born of the Virgin Mary, is my Lord, who has redeemed me, a lost and condemned person, purchased and won me from all sins, from death, and from the power of the devil.
Tuesday 3/2	Ephesians 4:2- Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love.
Friday 3/5	Apostles' Creed, Second Article (see above) and Meaning (Part 3): Not with gold or silver, but with His holy, precious blood and with his innocent suffering and death, that I may be his own, and live under Him in His kingdom and serve Him in everlasting righteousness, innocence, and blessedness, just as He is risen from the dead, lives and reigns to all eternity. This is most certainly true.
Tuesday 3/9	Matthew 26:42- My your will be done.
Friday 3/12	Apostles' Creed, Third Article: I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.
Tuesday 3/16	2 Corinthians 5:15- (Jesus) died for all.
Friday 3/19	Apostles' Creed, Third Article (see above) and Meaning (Part 1): What does this mean? I believe that I cannot by my own reason or strength believe in Jesus Christ, my Lord, or come to him; but the Holy Spirit has called me by the Gospel, enlightened me with His gifts, sanctified and kept me in the true faith. In the same way he calls, gathers, enlightens, and sanctifies the whole Christian Church on earth, and keeps it with Jesus Christ in the one true faith.
Tuesday 3/23	Apostles' Creed, Third Article (see above) and Meaning (Part 2): In this Christian Church He daily and richly forgives all my sins and the sins of all believers. On the Last Day He will raise me and all the dead, and give eternal life to me and all believers in Christ. This is most certainly true.
Friday 3/26	Revelation 22:13- (Jesus said,) "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End."
Tuesday 3/30	Luther's Morning Prayer: I thank you, my heavenly Father, through Jesus Christ, You dear Son, that You have kept me this night from all harm and danger; and I pray that you would keep me this day also from sin and every evil, that all my doings and life may please You.
