- Dec. 5 **First Commandment and Meaning**
“You shall have no other gods.”
What does this mean? We should fear, love, and trust in God above all things.
- Dec. 9 **Second Commandment and Meaning**
“You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God.” *What does this mean?* We should fear and love God so that we do not curse, swear, use satanic arts, lie, or deceive by His name, but call upon it in every trouble, pray, praise, and give thanks.
- Dec. 12 No Memory
- Dec. 16 **Third Commandment and Meaning** “Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.” *What does this mean?* We should fear and love God so that we do not despise preaching and His Word, but hold it sacred and gladly hear and learn it.
- Dec.19 She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins. Matthew 1:21
- Jan. 6 “I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies; and whoever lives and believes in me will never die.” John 11:25
- Jan. 9 **Fourth Commandment and Meaning**
“Honor your father and your mother.” *What does this mean?* We should fear and love God so that we do not despise or anger our parents and other authorities, but honor them, serve and obey them, love and cherish them.
- Jan. 13 “Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled. Matthew 5:6
- Jan. 16 **Fifth Commandment and Meaning**
“You shall not murder” *What does this mean?* We should fear and love God so that we do not hurt or harm our neighbor in his body, but help and support him in every physical need.

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- Jan. 20 **Sixth Commandment and Meaning**
“You shall not commit adultery.” *What does this mean?* We should fear and love God so that we lead a sexually pure and decent life in what we say and do, and husband and wife love and honor each other.
- Jan. 23 **Seventh Commandment and Meaning**
“You shall not steal.” *What does this mean?* We should fear and love God so that we do not take our neighbor’s money or possessions or get them in any dishonest way, but help him improve and protect his possessions and income.
- Jan. 27 **Eighth Commandment and Meaning**
“You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.” *What does this mean?* We should fear and love God so that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, slander him, or hurt his reputation, but defend him, speak well of him, and explain everything in the kindest way.
- Jan. 30 “He died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again.”

- Feb. 3 **Ninth Commandment and Meaning**
“You shall not covet your neighbor’s house.” *What does this mean?* We should fear and love God so that we do not scheme to get our neighbor’s inheritance or house, or get it in a way which only appears right, but help and be of service to him in keeping it.
- Feb. 6 **Tenth Commandment and Meaning**
“You shall not covet your neighbor’s wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.” *What does this mean?* We should fear and love God so that we do not entice or force away our neighbor’s wife, workers, or animals, or turn them against him, but urge them to stay and do their duty.
- Feb. 10 “My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one can snatch them out of my hand.” John 10:27-28
- Feb. 13 “Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith,

who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.” Hebrews 12:2

What is meant by daily bread? Daily bread includes everything that has to do with the support and needs of the body, such as food, drink, clothing, shoes, house, home, land, animals, money, goods, a devout husband or wife, devout children, devout workers, devout and faithful rulers, good government, good weather, peace, health, self-control, good reputation, good friends, faithful neighbors, and the like.
