JUST A LITTLE *Reminder*

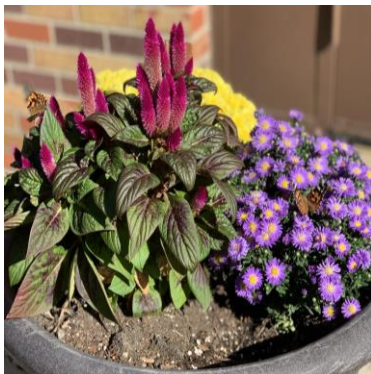

- ✓ Send Tylenol (labeled) and cough drops with a permission slip for your student's teacher.



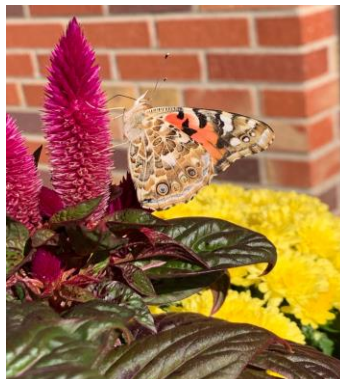
Recess Duty Volunteers
